International Student Scholarships

The University of Auckland International Student Scholarships are available to new full-fee paying international students at both postgraduate and undergraduate levels.

The scholarship is worth up to NZ\$10,000 for new international students who have received an unconditional offer of study to undertake a Postgraduate Diploma or taught Masters programme of 120 points or more, or an undergraduate degree for students with overseas secondary or post-secondary qualifications.

Success will be based on academic merit, the quality of the application letter, and endorsement by the applicant's referee. The selection committee may consider the applicant's country of origin, to align with the University's strategic aims.

The scholarships will be paid as a fees credit towards the first semester of study at the University of Auckland.
