

# FRACP Paediatric Part 1 Written Examination Weekly Teaching Programme (for Australian-based trainees)

Do you need help to pass the written examination?

## We provide

- A teaching programme preset to guide what topics to study and regularity of lectures ensures a good, steady pace for your study in the months leading up to the exam
- Teachers: Paediatricians (general, community and sub-specialty), child psychiatrists, a paediatric dentist and scientists
- 56 one-hour weekly interactive online lectures in real-time, and lecture recordings available on a website specifically aimed at providing a framework of the knowledge necessary for passing Part 1 Paediatrics Written Examinations. Access to the teaching website is extended until the Divisional Clinical Exam 2026
- 6 monthly practice MCQ exams of 32 questions each, compiled by the question writing team, which are integrated with the topic presentations. These are marked and critiqued.

- Paper 1 and 2 practice exams of 50 questions each in January 2026
- An opportunity to ask questions and argue

## Dates and times

The course begins on 5 June 2025 and continues through 29 January 2026. During these months the teaching programme is delivered every Thursday afternoon from 2–4pm (NZ time). Lecture recordings are uploaded on the website every Friday and remain available until the Divisional Clinical Exam in 2026.
