(i) This conjoint plan allows students to complete the degree program in five and a half years, but this involves a heavier-than-normal workload in four of those years. There is no requirement to finish within the minimum timeframe; students may choose to enrol for a more manageable load by extending their study period.

(ii) A BE(Hons)/LLB(Hons) conjoint degree meets the requirements of two professional bodies. Students should expect the program to take six years and a half years and are advised to consult with Student Hubs for guidance.

(iii) In Years 2 and 3, the order of LAW 201-241 can be adjusted. The accompanying diagram illustrates just one possible arrangement.

(iv) Students wishing to participate in a 60-point or 120-point Law Exchange in their final year may need to rearrange their degree structure and consider taking courses during Summer School (v) Students must enrol for the dissertation in the semester following completion of Part IV of the schedule for the Degree of Bachelor of Laws.
