BSc requires 360 points (24 x 15-point courses). Each box represents one 15 point course. It is the student's responsibility to check that the final programme complies with University Calendar Regulations.

- Of the 360 points required for this degree, a student must pass at least 315 points from courses listed as 'Courses available for the BSc' in the Bachelor of Science Schedule, including:
1. Courses in a minimum of three subject codes listed in the BSc Schedule.
  2. At least 180 points (12 courses) must be above Stage I.
  3. At least 75 points must be at Stage III, of which 45 points must be in the majoring subject, and 15 points from a capstone course listed in the BSc Schedule.
  4. 15 Points must be taken from the [Open or Engineering, Medical and Health Sciences, Science \(EMHSS\) Schedule](#).
  5. Up to 30 points (2 courses) may be taken from outside the Faculty.
