When can I view my exam script?

- Once grades have been posted to SSO your exam script will be available via Inspera within 48 hours.
- Your exam script remains available for **4 months**, you are able to view and/or download a copy within this timeframe.

How do I view my exam script?

What information is available in my script?

The first page of your script offers the following information:

1. Status of the question

The status appears as either Correct, Wrong, Partially correct.

2. Marks

The marks you achieved out of the possible marks. If there were questions within your exam that had multiple parts, you can only see the overall mark. For example, a File Upload question may have multiple parts, you only see the total marks.

3. Question type

For example, multiple choice, essay, file upload

For multiple-choice questions, you can see which questions you got correct and what the correct answer was for any wrong answers.
