- Coverage valid at least in Asia or worldwide
- Cap for medical expenses should be at least 80,000 euros
- Repatriation
- Civil responsibility

All international students will require a Student's Pass issued by the Immigration & Checkpoints Authority (ICA) during their candidature in ESSEC.
