<b>Decision</b>	Exchange Decisions should be communicated by the end of May
<b>Language</b>	For exchange students GSA would expect a B2 or equivalent

<b>Visa</b>	Students from outside the UK and Ireland are likely to require a visa to study at the GSA. If studying for less than six months (e.g. Semester long exchanges) you can join GSA with a Standard Visitor Visa. Students coming to the GSA for more than six months are required to apply for a Student Visa from the UK Visa and Immigration department (UKVI)
<b>Accommodation Options (Glasgow campus)</b>	Accommodation isn't guaranteed, though applications for GSA Halls of Residence, can be made once Exchange Decisions have been communicated.
