Nominations

You are invited to nominate exchange students to us.

On receipt of your nomination, an email with general information is sent to you and the nominated student. Once our office has reviewed and accepted the student nomination, detailed guidelines and a link to an exchange application will be sent to the student.

Student applications

We will send your students a link to start an online application after we review and accept your nomination.

All students must submit:

- transcript of studies
- personal statement
- preferred module choices
- a valid passport

Some students may need to provide evidence of their [knowledge of English](#).

Module/course guidance

Newcastle University maintains an [online list of modules](#) available to incoming exchange students. We also include guidance on understanding our academic structure and choosing modules. Exchange students can take 50-70 credits per semester.

Accommodation

We guarantee University accommodation to students from non-EU partners coming for a full academic year. While full-year students from European partners are not guaranteed accommodation, we encourage them to apply and can **usually** offer them a room.

Housing is difficult to find for students coming for one semester. We are happy to announce **we have secured an additional city-centre student accommodation site** and hope to be able to offer rooms to part-year students this year.
