

# New Start Special Admission - 2025 Entry Requirements to The University of Auckland

Minimum academic requirements for guaranteed entrance into undergraduate study from New Start for students meeting University Entrance through Special Admission. Effective for students applying for entry to the University of Auckland in 2024.

Entry to a University of Auckland Bachelor's degree requires University Entrance met through Special Admission with the minimum grade achieved in the relevant New Start course(s), plus completion of the required subject(s) as relevant. Special Admission is only open to students over 20 years of age before the semester start date who are New Zealand or Australian citizens or permanent residents. Lower GPAs may be considered for some programmes, subject to the availability of places.
